



ACI AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE OPENS at DULLES AIRPORT OFFERING LINE MAINTENANCE SERVICES at SUBSTANTIAL SAVINGS to AIRLINES

ACI Aircraft Maintenance has been launched at Washington Dulles International Airport after receiving FAA certification (Certificate Number QERR769X) as a FAR Part 145 repair station performing a wide range of high quality, attractive priced maintenance support services to all airline operators. Edwards, a United Kingdom native, earlier in his career opened maintenance operations in the United States for Virgin Atlantic, and was asked to return to British Airways where he was Maintenance Manager for East Coast stations. Brasie, whose aviation career began with the Strategic Air Command of the US Air Force, inaugurated ACI Aviation Consulting, Warrenton, Virginia, in 2000 , offering aircraft valuations and appraisals and other strategic services to corporate clients world-wide.
